You are hereby reminded to report to the Academy at the Peda Campus of the University of Bahir Dar from **07 July 2018**, but not later than **17:00 on 8 July 2018**, for the start of your programme. The first course in the programme is basic training. On successful completion of this course, you will start the 6-month course, Electro Technical Officer, which is the core course of the programme.
