To date four programmes with 58 graduates have been successfully conducted since March 2018.

2nd Engineer Tessema graduated from the first MEML programme in June 2018. After passing his EMAA written and oral examinations, he has served on several vessels of Vantage Shipping Lines as 2nd Engineer. He offers some perspective regarding how completing the MEML programme has been beneficial and some lessons.

BENEFITS IN COMPLETING THE MEML PROGRAMME

Q: How has serving as 2nd Engineer changed your life onboard?

A: The Masters, Chief Engineers and Chief Officers extend a big and great respect to me when I joined as a 2nd Engineer.

I have noticed that job and responsibility at the management level is not limited only at the second engineer level rather it is wider and goes beyond the specific task or responsibility. As a second engineer I am responsible for maintenance jobs and task all juniors to do jobs in accordance with company operating procedure and machineries instruction manuals.

Q: Has completing the MEML Programme benefitted you at home and financially?

A: I personally get paid a good salary as a second engineer and now I am married and own my property. EMTI S.C. also has arranged me to get a good loan from Zemen Bank which is a good opportunity for investment on property.

“On board I am creating a good positive working environment, trying to avoid a blame culture and appreciating the crew when the given job or task is completed or for their role on teamwork.”

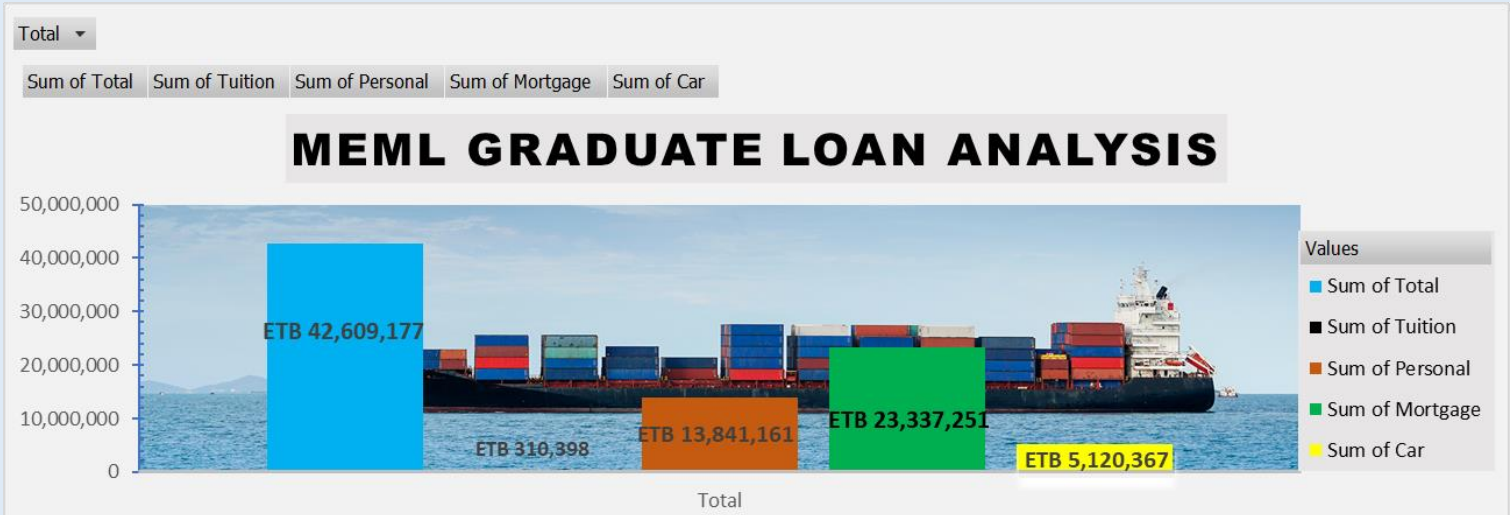
ADVICE TO THOSE STILL TO COMPLETE THE COURSE

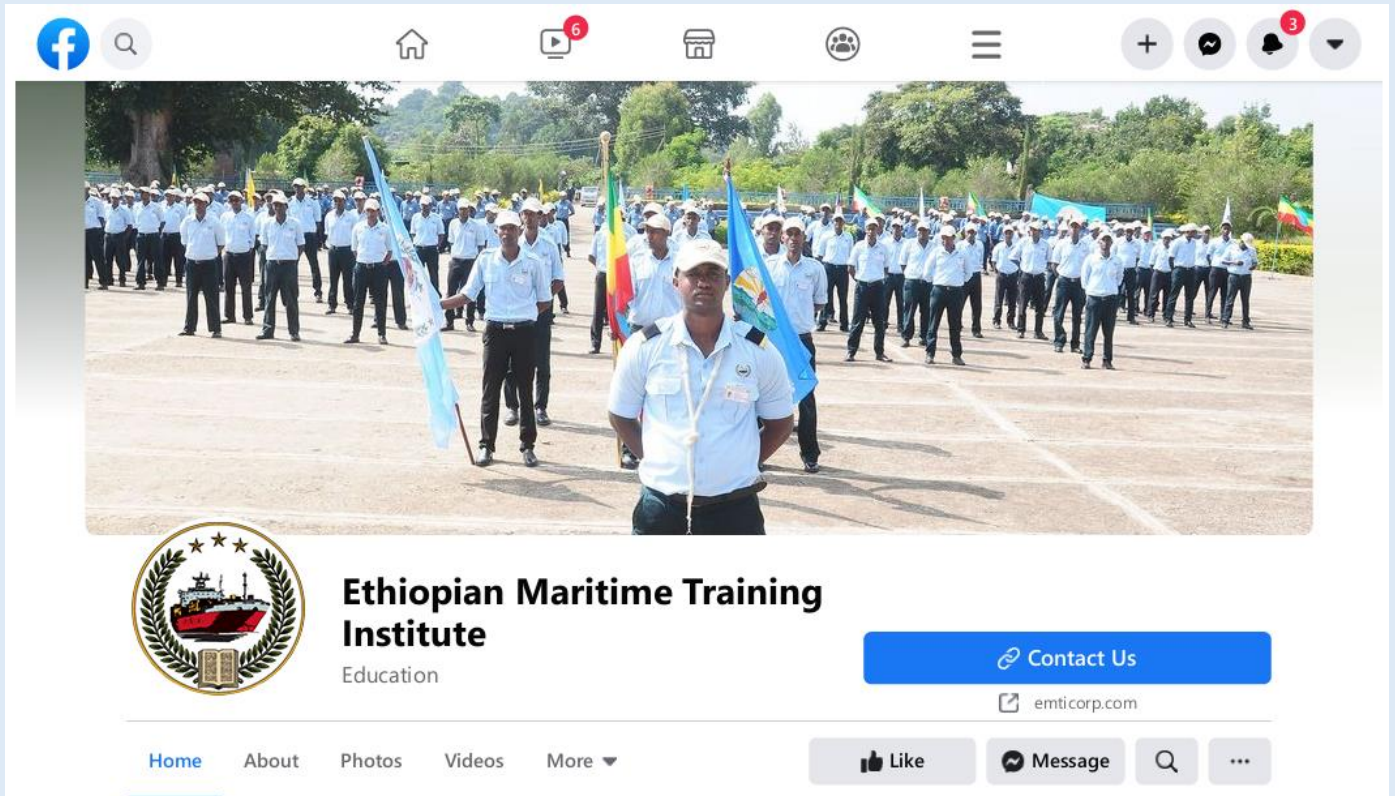
