THE NEXT STEP - FIRST CE QUALIFICATIONS

It has been a busy period for the first Marine Engineering Management Level (MEML) graduates over the past few years and some of them have been reaching the next step of qualifying as Chief Engineers since the start of 2022.

In order to achieve the final seagoing qualification as an Engineering Officer the candidates spend a month at the Academy attending the Chief Engineer Oral Preparatory Programme (CEOP) in order to prepare for their final Oral Examination with the EMA.

Since the beginning of 2022 4 CEOP programmes have been completed with 11 candidates attending. Seven of these have already successfully completed the EMA Chief Engineer Oral examination with the remainder due to sit within the next few months.

Chief Engineer Oral Preparation Programme (CEOP)

The EMTI Chief Engineering Oral Preparation (CEOP) Programme was instituted at the beginning of 2022 in order to comply with the Ethiopian Maritime Authority Requirement as stipulated in Marine Notice 1 of 2015 (Version 3 dated September 2021). The Marine Notice stipulates that after serving their required sea-time of 18 months as 2nd Engineers in order to prepare for their Chief Engineer Oral Examinations candidates are to spend a month on oral preparation at the Academy.

Oral preparation with the candidates is done by the CE lecturers at the Academy, based on the EMA approved curriculum, which focuses on Chief Engineer responsibilities and duties and covers in depth subjects as required at the Management Level. Some of these are listed below:

Regulatory Aspects (Knowledge of National and International Legislation).

ISM, Audits and Quality Management.

Classifications Societies and Certificates.

Ship's Stability.

Safety of Life at Sea Convention.

Logbooks and Documentation.

Monitoring and Controlling in Respect of Safety and Marine Pollution Prevention.

The World Health Organisation and International Labour Organisation.

Ship surveys and inspections for various entities.

Commercial/ Legal Aspects of Ship Operations.

Emergency Preparedness

Training


Budgeting, Management Information Systems, Inventory Management, Records.

Latest Technical Developments (Engines, Automation, Electrical, Electronics).

On completion of the CEOP candidates that attended the programme are issued a certificate by the Academy which is submitted to the EMA and then allows them to sit the Chief Engineer Oral Examination as scheduled by the EMA.
